This program will assist you to explore your options for the future

## **Term 1:**

Selection interviews with student and parent/s at your school to find out more about the program and how it can assist you

## **Term 2: Attend 1 day a week**

Complete part of Certificate I in Introductory Vocational Education

- Meet new people
- Communication at work
- How to work effectively in a team
- Prepare a resume
- Visit work sites
- Learn what to say during an interview

## **Term 3: Attend 1 day a week**

Complete a Vocational Education Training program in an industry of your choice such as :

- Retail
- IT
- Hospitality
- Screen printing
- Automotive
- Horticulture
- Community Service
- Construction

## **Term 4:**

Participate in a Structured Work Placement in an industry of your choice

This is like a work experience but you will have support from Disability Employment Network of your choice

## **Once completed, what can this program lead to?**

- Employment, including traineeship or apprenticeship
- Further Education/Training
- Support through a Disability Employment Network to gain and keep employment
